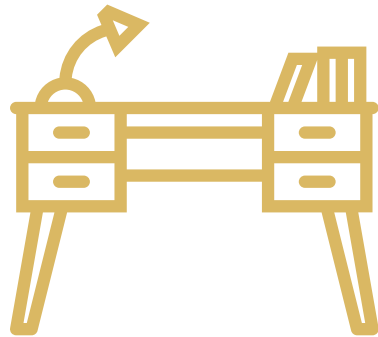

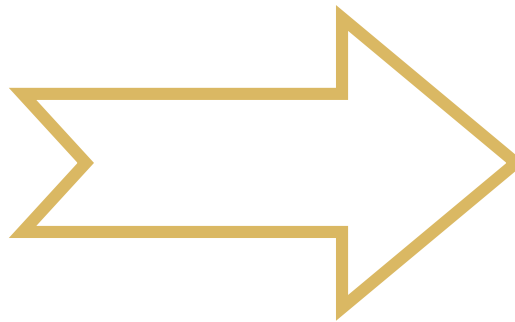

How it works

- Receive a Conditional Letter of Admission from the University of Rochester before you leave home
- Enroll at the College of Mount Saint Vincent for a minimum of three semesters or at least 40 transferable credits
- Transfer to the University of Rochester from where you will graduate

- Popular undergraduate programs include Engineering, Political Science, Economics, Biological and Biomedical Science and Visual and Performing Arts

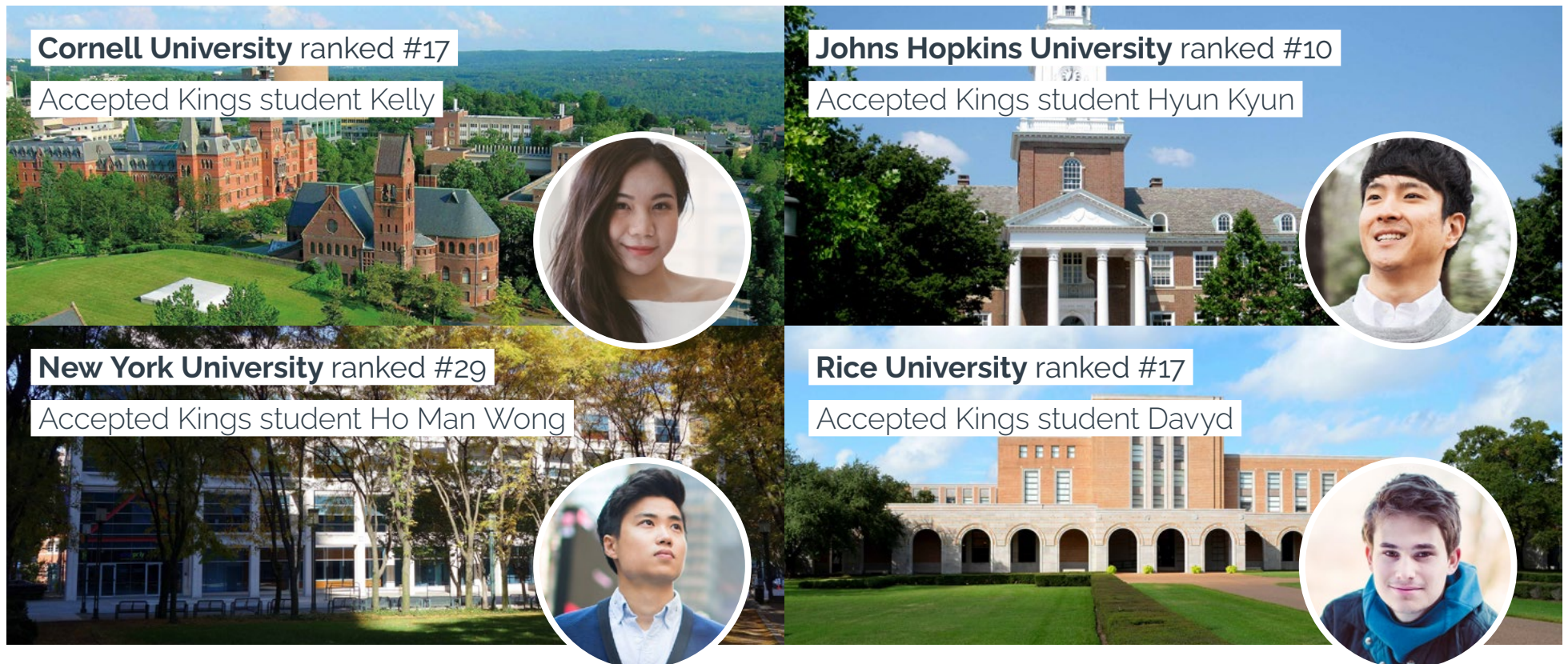
